

“Nomenclature” Mac/PC as used (often) in these courses

Apple	PC (if different)	used in course
shift		⇧
tab		⇧
ctrl	Windows (sometimes?)	⤴
alt (or option)	alt	⌥
cmd	ctrl	⌘
return or enter		↵

So for example **⌥⌘2** is

- **alt (or option)+cmd+2** on an Apple computer
- **alt+ctrl+2** on a PC.

Confusing?

Maybe keep this sheet for reference.

As an aside: this is what **roll-over** means:
(called also **mouse over** or just **hover**)

When navigating with a touch-pad or mouse, you can move the cursor (the pointer) over say an icon – this is called roll-over. Very often this triggers a reaction like a description, as shown in the example below.

Note that this cannot work on a touch-screen device like a smartphone, because on a touch-screen you can only click but not hover.
